


ART LESSON F: MAKE A RUBBING OF PAPER SHAPES

Learning Target: I can experiment in using different shapes

You will need:



- We are going to make a picture using paper shapes
- Use any paper to cut out a group of shapes. Make different shapes - big, small, long etc
- Glue your shapes onto a piece of paper. Overlap some of the shapes.
- Work on a smooth surface like a table . Place another piece of paper on top of your shapes and hold it steady with one hand. You could ask someone to hold the paper still for you.
- Use a crayon to take a rubbing of your shapes. Use different coloured crayons. Remember to use the EDGE of the crayon and not the POINT!
- How did it turn out? My glue was sticky, so the lumps of glue have shown up in my rubbing!
