




PPS Pupil Survey Feedback – January 2021

Which do you prefer?



59 responses




Action; Remind pupils to get in touch if they are finding their workload is too much, particularly where assignments are required to be submitted. There can be flexibility within that.




Action; Continue to provide balance of on and off screen activities


Action; continue to reassure pupils that they are all doing their best under difficult circumstances.
